Our school communities continue our traditions of gathering to worship throughout the year for liturgical celebrations, school events, meetings, and for reflection and solace. Our staff, in partnership with parents and parishes, helps to guide and inspire our students to become mature, caring and responsible citizens who exemplify the Ontario Catholic School Graduate Expectations. We are grateful for your involvement and commitment to our Board. We acknowledge the ongoing support of our staff and all Catholic stakeholders for their positive impact on Catholic education. We would like to thank each one of you for your dedication and support of our publicly-funded Catholic schools.
